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Short Note from our Country Director



Dear readers,

This quarter has been so fulfilling, since we managed to accomplish our main Target for this year that described to reach about four schools with the aim of providing 20 computers to each school and other ICT facilities so as to facilitate ICT learning in schools.

BACKGROUND STORY

ANM began in 1994, with 12 individuals in Arusha, Tanzania, pioneering email communication using line in Marie Benson's home. By 2010, ANM had 850 members, prompting the establishment of a profit-making company called **Habari Node Ltd**, with ANM as shareholders.

Despite this, ANM maintained its status as a society and later become registered as a non-governmental organization in August 2019 with Registration Number 01NGO/R2/000324.



ORGANIZATIONAL PURPOSE

Our Mission

Our mission is to instil a passion for and intergrate ICT skills at the basic educational level in Tanzania through mainstreaming digital educational resources, providing ICT equipment and teachers' capacity building in ICT.



Our support to schools is essential in today's digital age. We ensure student have access to the resources, Technology and assistance that student need. This support includes providing internet connectivity, devices and technical assistace all which are crucial in facillitating effective online education.



Our Objectives

1. To expand program reach
2. To strengthen strategic partnership.
3. To establish a secure funding base.
4. To enhance organizational capacity and governance
5. To diversify and grow the membership base.

Our Activities

1. Helping schools establish standard computer laboratories to enhance access to academic information through ICT.
2. Providing internet services for free or at subsidized cost to educational institutions.
3. Training teachers with basic ICT skills so as to improve learning through ICT
4. Providing Computers to schools that are in need depending on the availability of these computers and financial ability of the society at a particular moment.
5. Liaising and collaborating with like minded organizations and the government officials to attain our goals

Funding

ANM depends mostly on donations from individuals, NGOs and companies that share a similar passion.

ANM also gets some little income from annual membership fees(50,000/=)tsh per individual or an organization

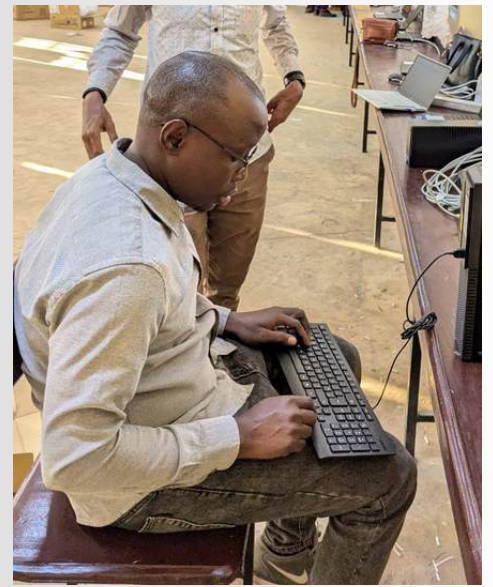
Programs and Projects

This year **2025**, we came up with a new project called **ElimuTech Initiative**. Its aim is to provide ICT facilities to Government Secondary schools around Tanzania, starting with Arusha region this year we focused on establishing four computer labs.

Initially, we have already completed three school in Arusha, which are;

- i. Akeri secondary school
- ii. Amsha secondary school
- iii. Madiira secondary school

In September this year we conducted a teachers' capacity building at Akeri secondary school as it is one of our activities and concern. It's main purpose was to provide the teachers with basic guides on how to use the Edubuntu and also the navigation throughout ANM's server.

Partnership & Collaboration

We have reached an agreement with the Arusha Regional Office, whereby each party has their roles and responsibilities. One of the key responsibilities of the Regional Office is to Integrate ANM activities into regional ICT educational plans.

Also, establishment of a Joint Working Group (JWG) comprising representatives from ANM, the regional education office, and regional ICT unit.



Impact metrics

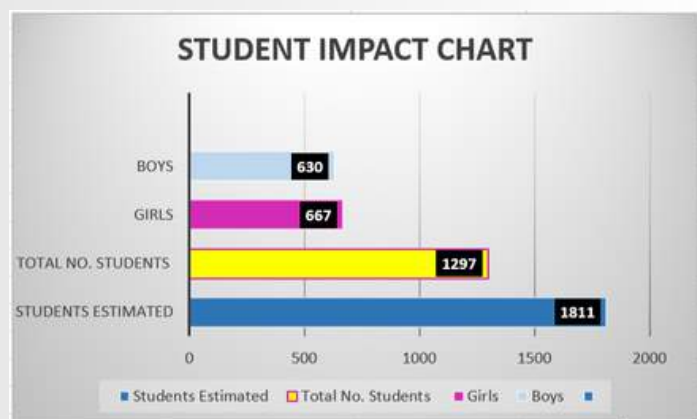
Expected number of students impacted in the first quarter of the project was 1811 students, to date we have impacted a total of 1297 students in the three schools we have done, this leaves aside one school that we are going to install the coming month of October.

ANM has impacted a total number of 667 girls, and a total number of 630 boys as a total sum of all the three schools we have done (Amsha Secondary School, Akeri Secondary School and Madiira Secondary School).

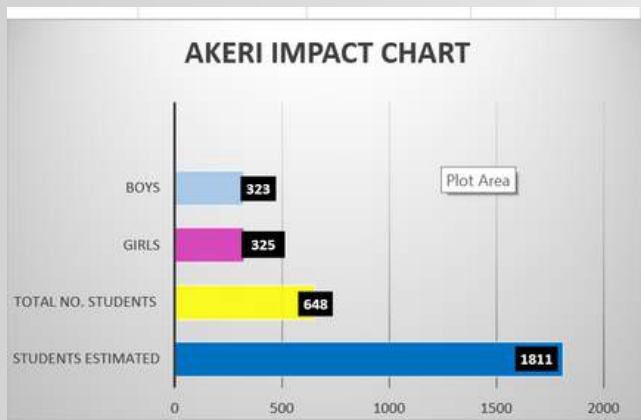
A total number of 648 students were impacted at Akeri Secondary School.

A total number of 532 students were impacted at Amsha secondary School.

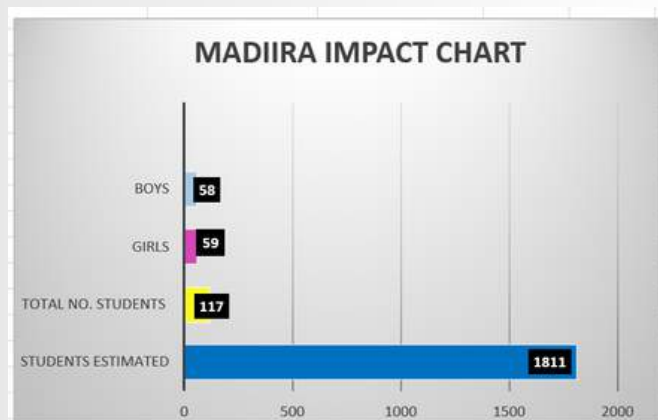
A total number of 117 students were impacted at Madiira secondary school.



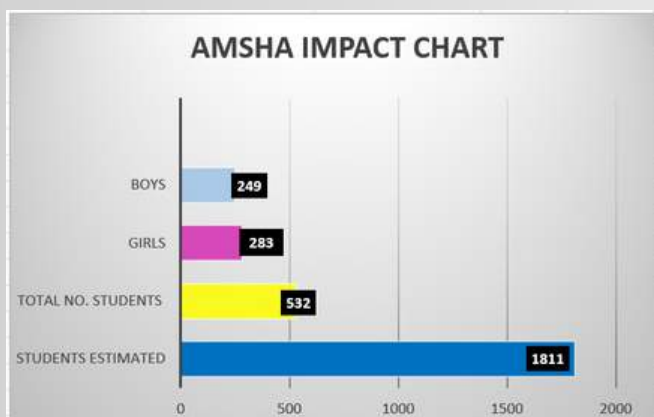
Total Student Impact Chart



Impact Chart of Akeri School



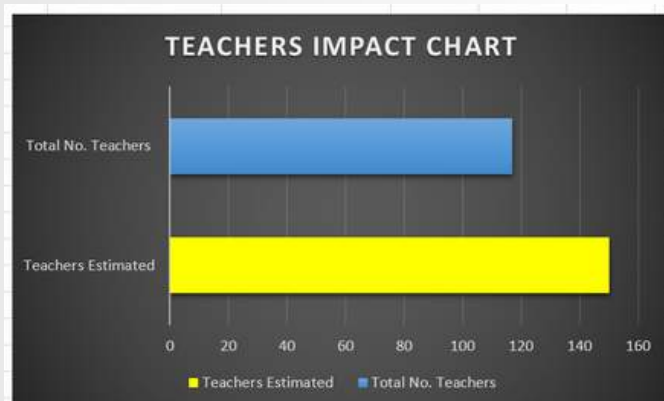
Impact Chart of Madiira School

The ElimuTech initiative has also impacted 89 teachers in which our expected number of impact was 150 which for four schools we estimated a total of about 38 teachers each school.
