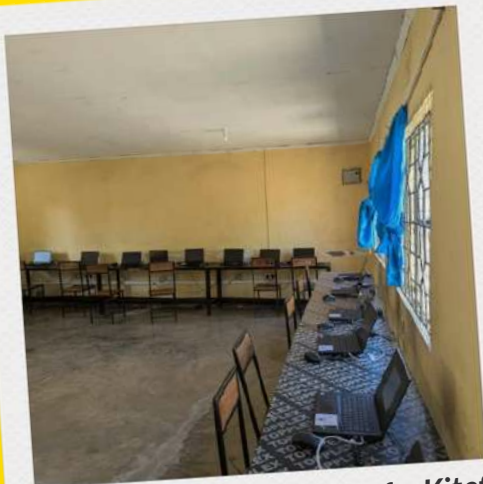
Hello and welcome to our quarterly newsletter! Our team is grateful to have you with us as we reflect on recent accomplishments and look ahead to new opportunities.

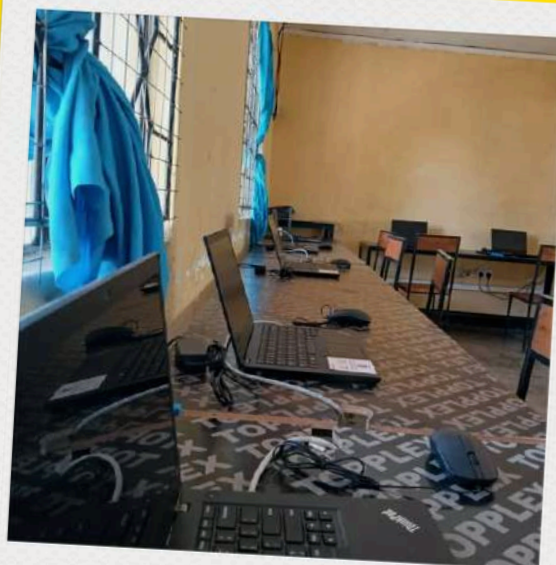


# KITEFU LABORATORY INSTALLATION

ANM has been continuing with the **Elimutech Initiative**, whereby the fourth laboratory at Kitefu Secondary school in Maji ya chai was accomplished.



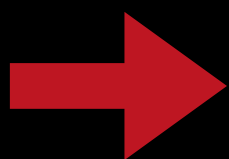
Left-side view of kitefu Computer

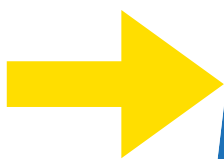

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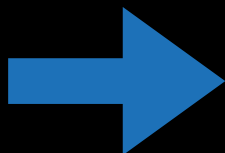

ANM also aims to receive computers from institutions that give out to the society and donation of any Local Network facility.

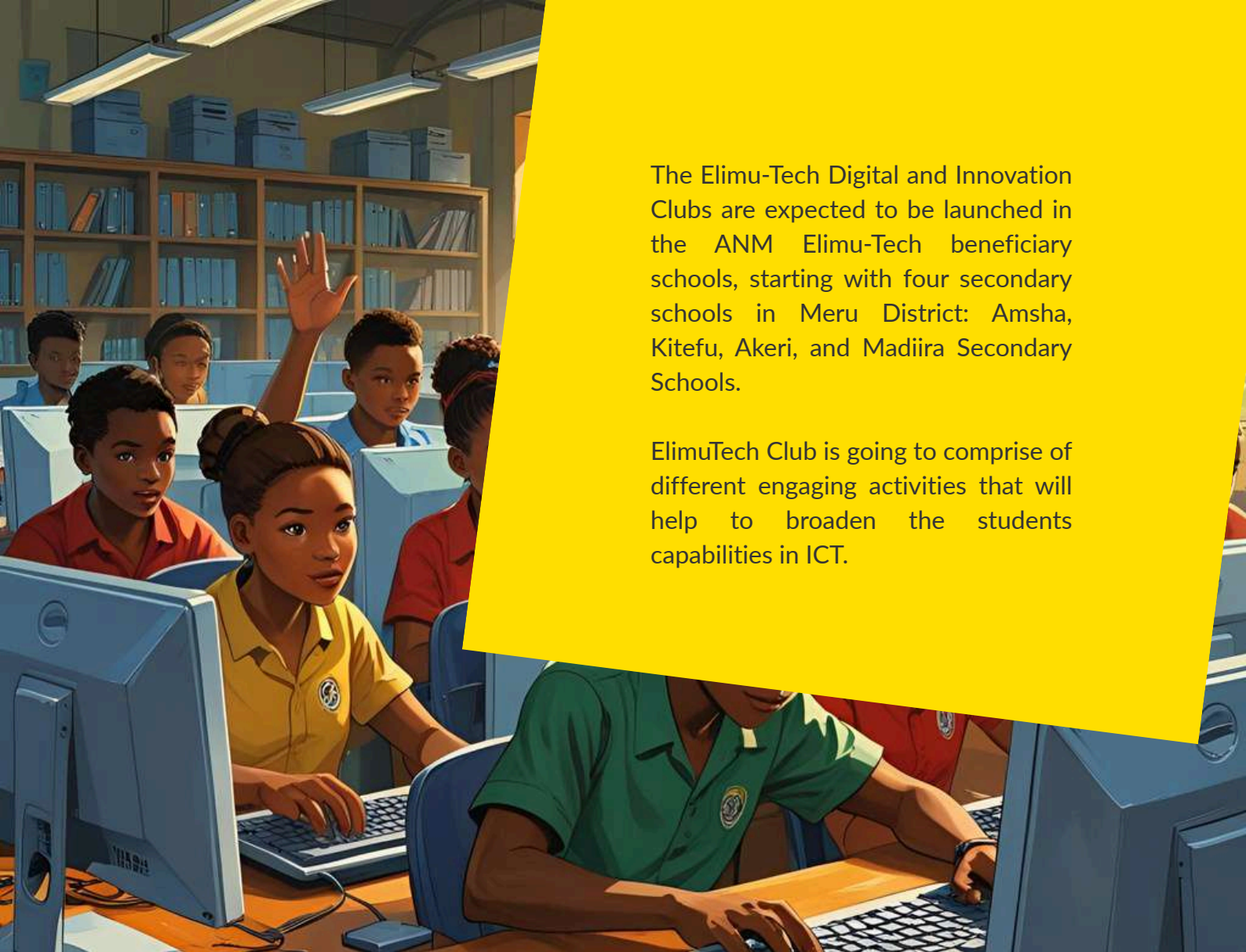


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## THE **EDIC** PROJECT

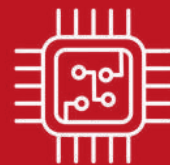
